

Let's think about the cross of Christ in this way:

The cross has arms that reach out to the side - and a trunk, or stem that reaches from down low to up high.

The arms of the cross remind me that we live our Christian life fully when we reach out our arms to our neighbors in love and friendship.

The stem or trunk of the cross reminds me of a tree that is deeply rooted and reaches up to the sky, and this speaks of our relationship with God. When we relate to God we reach down to the depths to seek God's love and look up to the sky to see where God is calling us to go.

The arms and the trunk meet in the center, right where we live.

God is in all of it: when we reach out to others, when we reach deep into ourselves, when we seek out what is to be.

Youth Group Fundraiser

Rules:

- 1) You are able to nominate a church member each week to be "Flamingo'd" – that means the Youth Group will set up a "flock" of flamingos in the nominee's yard. The "flock" remains in the yard until the following Sunday; when you, the nominee, will return the "flock" to church Sunday morning so it will be distributed in the next yard.
- 2) To nominate someone; you'll need to provide the persons name, physical address (so we are able to get the "flock" sent to the correct location) and this does come at a cost. It is a \$ amount you'd like to donate. All donations go to the Youth Group.
- 3) If you are one of **THOSE** that don't want the flamingos in your yard for everyone to see, you are able to purchase "Insurance" to protect your property for that week. This too, does cost a \$ amount you'd like to donate. Your "insurance" policy is only good for the week (Sunday to the following Sunday morning) you purchase it. All donations go to the Youth Group.
